Introduction: Birth of the SoW



2002: Creation of the System of Warranties by the WDC

Objectives:

- 1. Comply with
- 2. Support
- 3. Strengthen the Kimberley Process Certification Scheme through an industry selfregulation system

That system would not only cover trade in rough diamonds, but also trade in polished diamonds and jewelry with diamonds

> Through a warranty statement applied on both memos & invoices

Introduction: what changed in 16 years?



2002

The System of Warranties (SoW) was created by the WDC, in order to comply with, support and strengthen the emerging **Kimberley Process Certification Scheme** (KPCS).

The WDC itself was created by the WFDB and IDMA, thus transforming the SoW to the cornerstone of industry self-regulation.

In response to current challenges, WDC adopted a newly improved industry selfregulation instrument covering an expanded scope of compliance areas:

→ SoW Guidelines

Human rights, labor rights, anti-corruption and AML



The WDC launched its revised **System of Warranties** (SoW) on September 21st, 2021, the UN International Day of Peace.

This initiative is a **global mechanism** that was **designed for** and meant to be **used by the global diamond industry.**

The revised SoW consists now of an online self assessment that allows to apply the revised declaration.

The Revised SoW is a **global mechanism**, not a standard,

→ therefore, it is **not audited**

It could be obligatory in certain cases: RJC certification, or DDE membership



CONSUMERS' EXPECTATIONS

To expect a flourishing and healthy industry all across the supply chain, our Industry MUST meet ever changing consumers' expectations.

It starts with SoW and its extension of warranty of "conflict-free origin" delivered by the KP Certificates.



The layer approach: industry built on KP certification by creating the SoW and then developed bespoke industry standards like RJC Code of Practices, on top of which private corporations added their own like De Beers and its Best Practice Principles.

WHAT IS THE SoW?



1) WHAT:

SoW is a warranty statement added to B2B invoices or memos, that needs to be applied every time a rough or polished diamond changes hands, both loose and set in jewelry.

2) **HOW:**

Diamond industry members are now required to take a **self assessment** to help them **build OR confirm** their responsible practices **before** applying the warranty on memos and invoices.

A unique identification number **will be given** to each applicant upon **successful submission** of self assessment.

→ ID number can be shared at discretion with business partners, confirming compliance with

the SoW Guidelines

WHY ?!

To ensure the buyer that the diamond originates from a source compliant with the KPCS and SoW Guidelines

To preserve confidence across our value chain and change the narrative around our industry

OPEN FOR ALIGNMENT EXERCISE


Alignment with third-party standards and national regulations:

Revised text of Warranty to be used WORD FOR WORD

"The diamonds herein invoiced have been {sourced}* purchased from legitimate sources not involved in funding conflict, in compliance with United Nations Resolutions and corresponding national laws {where the invoice is generated}**.

The seller hereby guarantees that these diamonds are conflict free and confirms adherence to the WDC SoW Guidelines."

^{*{}sourced} - may be used by companies that do not purchase from open market, but source and aggregate diamonds from production facilities that are owned/partly owned by them

^{**{}where the invoice is generated} - may be used by companies if they specifically want to reference the country of invoice issuance



- Who is concerned → Buyers and Sellers of rough and polished diamonds and diamond jewelry
- How
 by passing on the warranty statement each time diamonds and diamond jewelry
 change hands, after successfully submitting their completed self assessment via the online
 platform
- Transition period → the old warranty will still be valid during three (3) years in case of rough purchases (Sept 2024) and five (5) years in case of all other purchases (Sept 2026)


